### **AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF THE UNIVERSITY OF ALABAMA**

#### Section 1. Findings

- A. There is the potential to improve the Student Organization Seating Allocation process because of the advancement of the Crimson Tide Rewards program, which will indicate students' loyalty in attending football games and staying for four quarters of the games.
- B. Because of the date of the start of the school year and the first home football game the current binding timeline in the governing legislation does not allow the Board of Governors and the organizations applying for Student Organization Seating adequate time to prepare the rubric, presentations, map, and handle appeals.
- C. The ever changing nature of both technology regarding football tickets and attendance as well as that of the academic calendar require that an inflexible timeline and guideline for allocations be removed.

#### Section 2. The Amendment

The content in Articles VI – XIII shall remain the same but shall be shifted up one (1) Roman numeral so as to produce the following:

Article VI – Judicial Branch now becomes Article V – Judicial Branch

Article VII – First Year Council now becomes Article VI – First Year Council

Article VIII – The Code of Laws now becomes Article VII – The Code of Laws

Article IX– Elections now becomes Article VIII – Elections

Article X – Impeachment and Removal now becomes Article IX – Impeachment and Removal

Article XI – Amendments and Convention now becomes Article X – Amendments and

Convention Article XII – Supremacy now becomes Article XI – Supremacy

Article XIII – Ratification now becomes Article XII – Ratification
