RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF STALKING AWARENESS WEEK

WHEREAS, The Student Government of the University of Alabama was established to represent student concerns in all University wide matters, and;

WHEREAS, The Senate is the legislative body of the University of Alabama Student Government Association is given the responsibility of carrying out such legislative acts that are necessary and proper for the Student Body of the University of Alabama.; and;

WHEREAS, 11.2% of students experience cases of rape or sexual assault on college campuses, and 90% of victims know their offender, and ;

WHEREAS, those aged 18-24 experience the highest rate of stalking, with 13% of college women reporting being stalked with an average duration of 1.8 years;

WHEREAS, The University of Alabama has a vested interested in protecting and supporting it's student body;

BE IT RESOLVED THAT, The University of Alabama 23rd SGA Senate shows continued support of establishing Stalking Awareness Week from January 22-25, as well as the adaptation of the "Model Stalking Policy" in The University of Alabama Title IX office.
