Appeal for Judicial Review

**NO JUDGEMENT RENDERED**

On September 6th, 2021 at 6:55pm, Chief Justice Curl received an appeal for Judicial Review from Students Garrett Burnett and Sarah Shield. The next day, September 7th, 2021, Chief Justice Curl began proceedings for Judicial Review, pursuant to Title IV, Chapter 401.4.2.1<sup>1</sup> of the Student Government Association Code of Laws. A Panel of Inquiry was formed, consisting of six Associate Justices, the Counselor to the Chief Justice, and the Chief Justice and a Board of Governors member as non-voting parties.

On September 9th, 2021 at 4:20pm, the Complainants withdrew their appeal from consideration from the Court via email to Chief Justice Curl. The Complainants submitted their withdrawal before the Panel of Inquiry was set to meet. As this Court requires that a live case exists and the fact that the Complainants are no longer seeking relief from the Court, this case is moot and there will be no judgement rendered.
