**A BILL TO ESTABLISH THE SENATE ADMINISTRATIVE  
POSITIONS OF CHIEF OF STAFF AND DIRECTOR OF OUTREACH  
WITHIN THE CODE OF LAWS**

*Be it enacted by the Senate of the Student Government Association  
assembled.*

Section 1. Findings:

- A. Keeping a record of hours earned in the Student Government Association serves as a way to log progress and attendance for each member.
- B. SGA officers or members who receive a salary must maintain their required hours in order to receive their salary.
- C. The SGA website will contain the monthly hours of each individual in all branches.
- D. Clarification on SGA elected and appointed member's requirements will alleviate current and future confusion.

Section 2. Legislation: **changes in red**

Chapter 303 Officers of the Senate

Chapter 303.1 The Executive Vice President shall serve as the ceremonial leader of the Senate and carry

out the duties outlined in Article III, Section 5, Subsection A of the SGA Constitution.

#### Chapter 303.2 The Speaker of the Senate

Chapter 303.2.1 The Speaker of the Senate shall be a Senator that is chosen from within the membership of the Senate by a majority vote.

Chapter 303.2.2 The Speaker of the Senate shall receive a salary that is determined by the SGA Executive Council and approved by the SGA Senate.

Chapter 303.2.3 The Speaker of the Senate shall not be forced to give up any rights that he or she has gained as a Senator. The Speaker of the Senate retains the right to vote on business that comes before the Senate floor.

#### Chapter 303.3 Speaker Pro Tempore

Chapter 303.3.1 The Speaker Pro Tempore shall preside over the Senate at the direction of the Speaker or in his or her absence.

Chapter 303.3.2 The Speaker Pro Tempore may be any duly sworn member of the Senate

Chapter 303.3.3 The Speaker Pro Tempore shall be nominated by the speaker and confirmed by a majority (fifty percent plus one) vote of all duly sworn Senators. Votes made by proxies shall not be counted.

#### Chapter 303.4 The Parliamentarian of the Senate

Chapter 303.4.1 The Parliamentarian of the Senate shall be a non-Senator appointed by the Speaker of the Senate and confirmed by the Senate and shall advise the Senate on matters of parliamentary procedure.

Chapter 303.4.2 The Speaker of the Senate may, at his or her discretion, replace the Parliamentarian.

Chapter 303.4.3 The Parliamentarian shall immediately resign if he has a conflict which prevents him from attending regular Senate business meetings.

#### Chapter 303.5 The Secretary of the Senate

Chapter 303.5.1 The Secretary of the Senate shall be a Senator that is chosen from within the membership of the Senate by a majority vote of the Senate.

Chapter 303.5.2 The Secretary of the Senate shall be responsible for making available the voting, office hours, and attendance records of the Senators.

Chapter 303.5.3 The Secretary of the Senate shall not have the authority to amend legislation that the SGA President has signed.

Chapter 303.5.4 The Secretary of the Senate shall receive a salary that is determined by the SGA

Executive Council and approved by the SGA Senate.

Chapter 303.5.5 The Secretary of the Senate shall not be forced to give up any rights that he or she has gained as a Senator. The Secretary of the Senate retains the right to vote on business that comes before the Senate floor.

#### Chapter 303.6 Secretary Pro Tempore

Chapter 303.6.1 The Secretary Pro Tempore shall serve the Senate at the direction of the Secretary or in his or her absence.

Chapter 303.6.2 The Secretary Pro Tempore may be any duly sworn member of the Senate.

Chapter 303.6.3 The Secretary Pro Tempore shall be nominated by the Secretary and confirmed by a majority (fifty percent plus one) vote of all duly sworn Senators. Votes made by proxies shall not be counted.

#### Chapter 303.7 Chief of Staff

Chapter 303.7.1 The Chief of Staff shall be a non-senator appointed by the Speaker of the Senate and shall be the primary administrative officer of the Senate and support members of the Senate in the creation and implementation of passed measures.

Chapter 303.7.2 The Speaker of the Senate may, at his or her discretion, replace the Chief of Staff.

Chapter 303.7.3 The Chief of Staff shall immediately resign if they have a conflict which prevents them from attending regular Senate business meetings.

#### Chapter 303.8 Director of Outreach

Chapter 303.8.1 The Director of Outreach shall be a non-senator appointed by the Speaker of the Senate and shall focus on strengthening the relationship between the Senate and the broader campus community and increasing awareness of the duties, actions, and responsibilities of the Senate

Chapter 303.8.2 The Speaker of the Senate may, at their discretion, replace the Director of Outreach.

Chapter 303.8.3 The Director of Outreach shall immediately resign if they have a conflict which prevents them from attending regular Senate business meetings.

Chapter 303.9 The Senate may create any other Senate officer positions as it sees fit.

**AN ACT TO APPROVE THE STUDENT ORGANIZATION FUNDING REQUESTS

**Section 1. Findings:**

1. The Financial Affairs Committee met on April 4th, 2022.
2. The committee heard 9 requests from 8 organizations before making its decisions.
3. \$1,882,08 was deducted from organizations' requested amount due to the funding price cap of \$7,500.00 per organization per fiscal year, merchandise and beverages not allowed for funding, the \$500 individual traveler cap per fiscal year, and the inability to request money for fundraisers.
4. 93.81% of the total requested amount was awarded.

**Section 2. Legislation:**

1. ***Therefore, be it resolved,*** the Senate approves the following FAC funding requests by SOURCE student organizations for a total award of \$28,513.28 with details listed in the Excel sheet attached.
