Preliminary Injunction Update

INJUNCTION LIFTED

THIS MATTER initially came before the Court on March 3rd, 2023. On this day, an official injunction was issued, halting the certification of each of the contested Student Government Association elections for the 2022-2023 academic year. The injunction was initially issued due to the nature of the allegations against the appellees or the potential for irreparable harm to the appellants, where the Court heard Elections Appeals 23-001 to 23-008 pertaining to various candidates and their respective campaigns.

As the Elections Board has had time to hear all violations and potential appeals, the Court has since conducted official judicial procedure for each of the aforementioned appeals, informed all parties of any necessary action to be taken, and released the official Opinion(s) from the Court, each of the matters disputed in Appeals 23-001 to 23-008 is considered settled. As such, the Court has deemed it proper for each of the previously uncertified elections to be ratified by the Elections Board.
