Organizations were graded based upon their applications and the rubric below:

- 34% of the grade came from the grade point averages of the CWID numbers that each organization submits.

- 33% of the grade came from the organization's interview.
- 11% of the grade came from DEI Passport Certification.
- 11% of the grade came from Tide Loyalty Points.
- 11% of the grade came from Bama Pulse service hours.

This year, two rotating blocks will be utilized totaling 393 seats. An email regarding rotating block opt-in will be sent to all Source-registered organization leaders in the near future.
